

## Phillip Island Golf Club - Men's Championships - Stroke

Club Championships are decided over 4 rounds of stroke play (72 holes) for Open, A grade nett, B grade gross & nett and 3 Rounds (54 Holes) for C grade gross & nett & D grade gross and nett.

Play for all grades will be on each of the three Saturdays following the PIGC AGM which is scheduled on the first Saturday following Cup Day.

The Open, A & B grades will play their 3<sup>rd</sup> round on the Sunday following the second Saturday.

In the case of bad weather or other adverse circumstances, the Match Committee reserves the right to nominate an alternative date, play 36 holes in any one day or shorten the event to a minimum 36 holes.

Handicap divisions will be:

A Grade 0 - 9 daily h'cap B Grade 10 - 16 daily h'cap C Grade 17 - 23 daily h'cap D Grade 24 - 40 daily h'cap

Handicaps as at midnight on the Friday preceeding the first round will be used for the 4/3 rounds of the championships but will be adjusted for the events of the day.

A Junior (under 21) gross and nett and a Senior (over 70) nett Club Champions will be decided in conjunction with the event.

The order of play for rounds 3 & 4 (A&B) will be according to the progressive scores in the previous rounds, i.e. a seeded draw for the top 8 players in each grade. The draw for the final Saturday will be added to the time sheet prior to being live on the following Monday.

Ties in the scratch events will be decided by a sudden death play off using holes 1 & 9. Ties in handicap events will be decided by a count-back. In multi round events the last 18 holes will be used and if still tied the usual count-back of last nine will be applied.
